- Cookie Dough Fundraiser: Thank you to all FES Families for participating in this year's fundraiser! We made a total profit of \$11,237.60!
- Teacher/Staff Appreciation Week: Teacher Appreciation Week is May 2-6. We discussed ideas to supply the teachers/staff with a special treat every day of the week.


## Motions:
